











Ibuprofen dosage chart for infants and children 11 years and younger

Ibuprofen	If possible, use weight to dose; otherwise, use age.

Important instructions

You may repeat the dose every 6 to 8 hours while symptoms last

Do **NOT** give more than 4 doses in 24 hours

Talk to your child's healthcare professional before giving any other product containing an NSAID*

*Nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug

What you can do

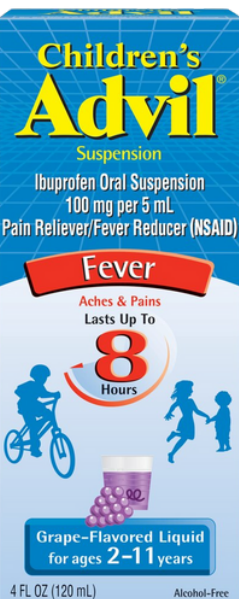
- Always read and follow the medicine label.
- Find the dose for your child's **current weight**. If you are not sure of your child's weight, use age. As children grow, their doses change over time.
- Use **only the dosing device that came with the medicine** (syringe or dosing cup).
- Wait the correct amount of time between doses. If you give another dose too soon, it could harm your child.
